NOTIFICATION

The University Administration has received complaints and reports indicating acts of gross indiscipline committed by Shri Harpal Singh Sangwan while being a student of full time regular Intensive Bulgarian Course in the Department of Slavonic & Finno-Ugrian Studies. It has come to the light of the authorities that Shri Harpal Singh Sangwan is in a habit of misbehaving with the staff, both teaching and non-teaching and is very aggressive in his attitude. Despite an earlier bar of 5 years (2007-2012) on his admission to any course in Delhi University and his subsequent apology in the Court dated 15th December 2008, he has not changed his attitude and behaviour. These acts and instances constitute gross indiscipline within the meaning of Clause 3, particularly its sub clauses (a) and (i) of Ordinance XV-B of the University.

After carefully examining the matter in detail and the recommendations of the Fact Finding Committee constituted to enquire into the incident, the Vice-Chancellor, under the powers vested under Ordinance XV-B, has, in order to maintain discipline, directed that Shri Harpal Singh Sangwan be debarred from admission to any course in the Department of Slavonic & Finno-Ugrian Studies, University of Delhi for a period of 5 years.
