Selection procedure of M.Phil. 2018

With reference to the Minutes of the M.phil. Committee meeting held on 31st May, 2018 in the Department of Commerce, Delhi University, following is the shortlisting/selection criteria of M.phil. 2018.

i. **Through Entrance Test**-As per the ordinance VI, the short listing criterion for candidates who appeared through Entrance Test is 50% marks and above. The number of candidates to be shortlisted for interview will be three times the number of seats available in each category subject to fulfilling the above mentioned criterion

ii. **Through NET/NET+JRF**- For shortlisting purpose merit will be on the basis of:

UG Marks - 35% weightage

PG Marks - 35% Weightage

The number of candidates to be called for interview will be three times the number of seats available in each category.

iii. **Selection criterion for candidates shortlisted through Entrance and NET/NET+JRF:**

For evaluation the weightage will be given to UG marks, PG marks and Interview including JRF. Accordingly each component will have weightage as following:


UG Marks – 35%


PG Marks – 35%

Interview – 25%

JRF – 5%

A differential of 5% between B.Com (Hons) and B.Com (Pass) will be taken up as per existing practice. The candidate's performance in the interview will be determined as Ordinance VI on the basis of (i) his/ her ability to demonstrate his/her competence to carry out research work, (ii) the suitability of the research work to be undertaken at the university level and (iii) the contribution of the proposed area of research to new/ additional knowledge in the field.
